Bill Boehman became Vice President of Yamaha Marine Group in March of 2016. The Marine Group Company is a unit of Yamaha Motor Corporation, U.S.A. and is located in Kennesaw, Ga., an Atlanta suburb. As Vice President, Boehman has a broad range of operational duties within the group. He also serves as Vice President of Precision Propeller Industries, Inc. (PPI), and Vice President, Skeeter Products, Inc., both wholly owned, independently operated subsidiaries of Yamaha Motor Corporation, U.S.A.

From 2008 to 2016, Boehman served as General Manager of PPI, which produces Yamaha and Turbo® branded propellers. During his tenure with PPI, Boehman oversaw the addition of a 12,000-square-foot manufacturing space, increased the plant's output by 300 percent, and reduced scrap ratios from five percent to less than one percent. The foundry industry average remains at seven percent.

Boehman has broad experience in manufacturing plant management and has spent the better part of his career improving manufacturing efficiency in roles that included plant controller, materials manager and Six Sigma® Black Belt. He has worked in a variety of positions with global component suppliers such as Lear® Corporation and Webasto®.

Boehman graduated from the University of Kentucky with a degree in finance and economics. He also holds a master's degree in manufacturing management from Southern Methodist University. He, his wife, Judith, and three children live in the Kennesaw, Ga., area.
